

Cryomodulation for the Reduction of Inflammation in Patients with Rosacea

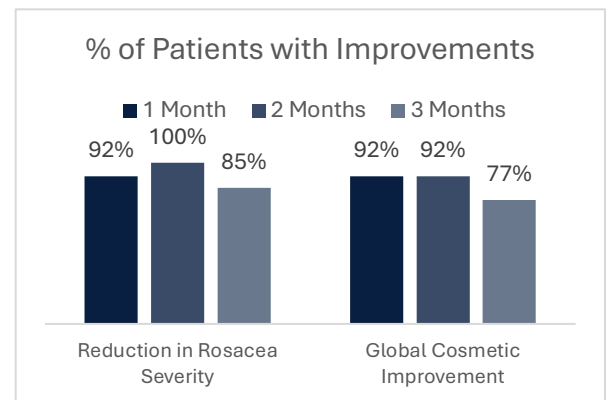
A prospective, multi-center clinical study to evaluate the Glacial® Rx System in patients with rosacea enrolled 20 subjects who received a series of five Glacial Glide Rx treatments at 2-week intervals.¹

RESULTS

- >90% of patients had a reduction in rosacea severity at 1 and 2 months after final treatment
- >90% of patients were rated by the investigator as having global cosmetic improvement at 1 and 2 months
- Patients reported reduced redness, reduced papules and pustules, and less frequent blushing
- Patients reported secondary cosmetic benefits, including improved skin tone and texture and improved skin brightness and clarity
- 100% of patients rated the procedure as comfortable and would recommend the treatment to others
- No treatment side effects, no device-related adverse events

CONCLUSIONS

Study data supports using cryomodulation® to suppress inflammation in patients with rosacea, reducing symptoms and improving skin appearance.
